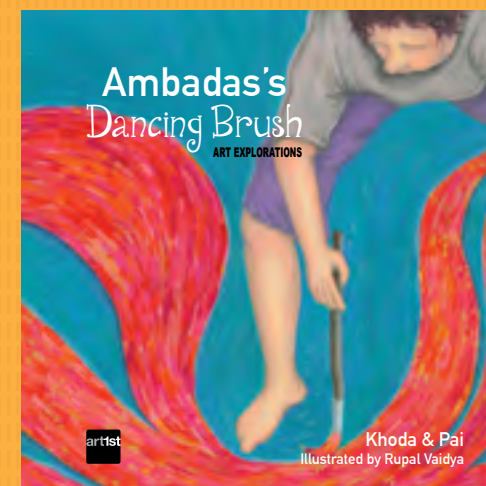
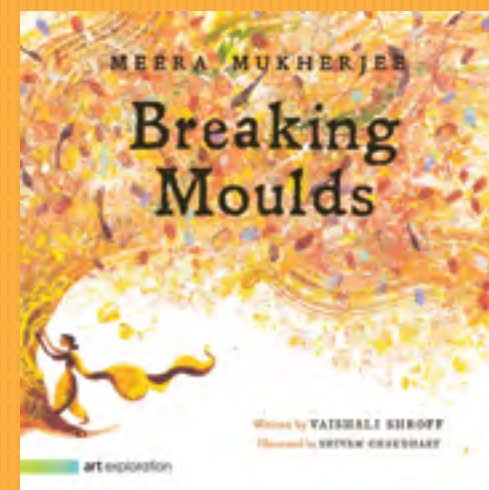
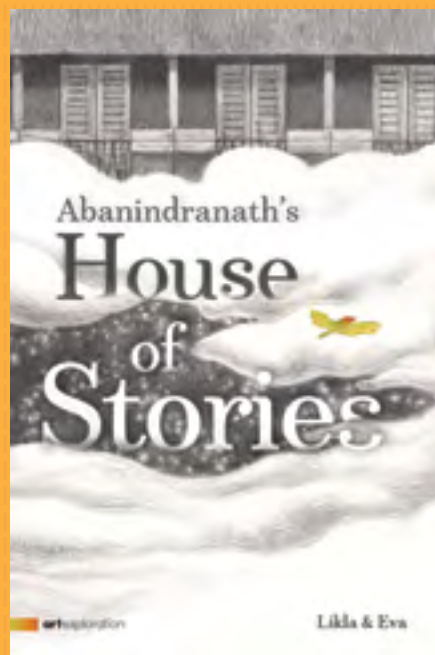

Age Group: 6-8 years

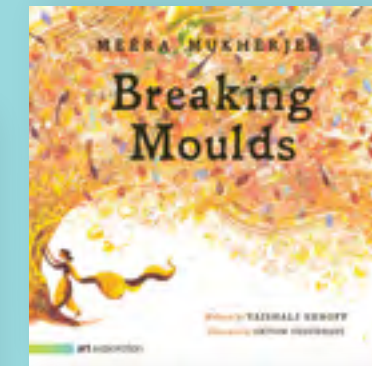

This series serves as a sandbox for young learners to look at a variety of subjects like History, Mathematics, Language, Geography, Activism through works of Indian art.



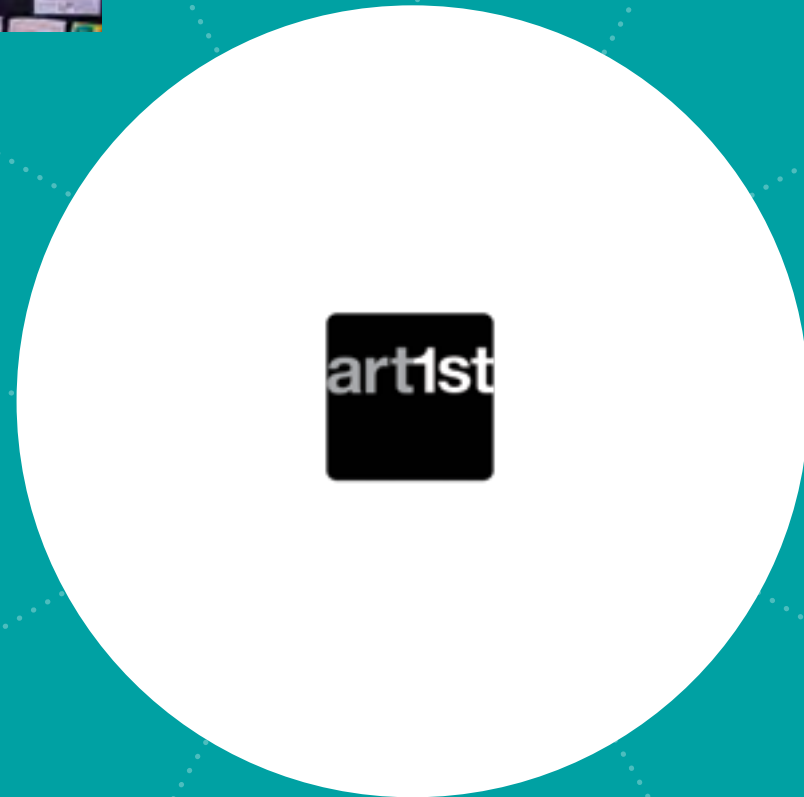
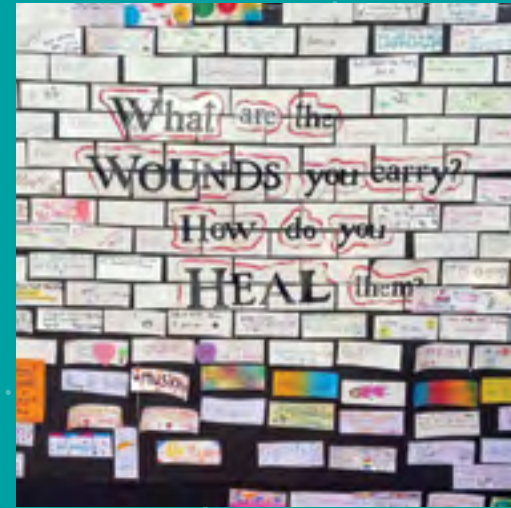


Eye Spy
