

The **Visual Learning Series** uses an interdisciplinary game-based approach to enhance visual literacy and cognitive skills for the preschool curriculum.

# Level 1: Magical World of the Wild

At 4-6 years, children are fascinated by animals, this informed selection of the theme - **Magical World of the Wild**.

The book encourages children to **observe** and **explore** the world of animals through compelling artworks by well-known artists.

The visuals in the book introduce children to Miniature, Folk, Modern and Contemporary Indian art.



Magical World of the Wild Book (Covers and Chapters)


Each chapter is designed in the form of games that are adapted to make children seek alternative creative avenues.

Each chapter can be extended into an **in-depth art exploration** through different Art Labs. Selected Sample Lesson Plans will be shared with the teachers at the free training session.



## Let's Count

Children are drawn to look closer as the artworks challenge the simple visuals that usually go with this activity. The question cues bring focus to various aspects of the animals and birds.



## Domestic or Wild

Children are introduced to a visual vocabulary of animals. They begin to recognize the context (homes) that differentiates the animals (domestic or wild).



### Spot the Animal

This chapter contains a curious collection of horses and tigers. The variety in visuals encourages the idea that a single subject can be represented in a many different ways.

### Find the Difference:

Children improve their observation skills as they dive into the minute details of the paintings and notice differences in colour, form, position, perspective and more.



# Level 2: People and Places

As children become more comfortable with leaving home, travelling to school and interacting with people outside their family circle, we present them with a new theme - **People and Places**.

The book encourages them to develop a visual understanding of their **culture** and **environment** including people, neighbourhood and workplaces.



People and Places Book (Covers and Chapters)

As with Level 1, each chapter is in the form of **age appropriate games**. Here too, the teachers will be provided with information on how to use the book to implement additional art activities in the class.

The visuals in the book introduces children to the works of Indian artists from the **Mughal era to Contemporary art**.



## Count

The familiar counting activity is levelled up as the children are presented with more visually complex artworks.




## Spot the Difference:


The children identify a variety of places and people as they look deeper to find the differences.



## Sort and Order


A simple game with stickers is paired with questions that encourage the viewer to think critically about the painting.





### Guess the Place

Here's a riddle that helps viewers identify and spell the place that they are looking at.




### Missing Person

A person is missing on each page. The little detectives have to identify them from a sticker sheet and place them back in context, in an exploration of shapes and sizes.

An eye-spy game that improves spelling and vocabulary.
